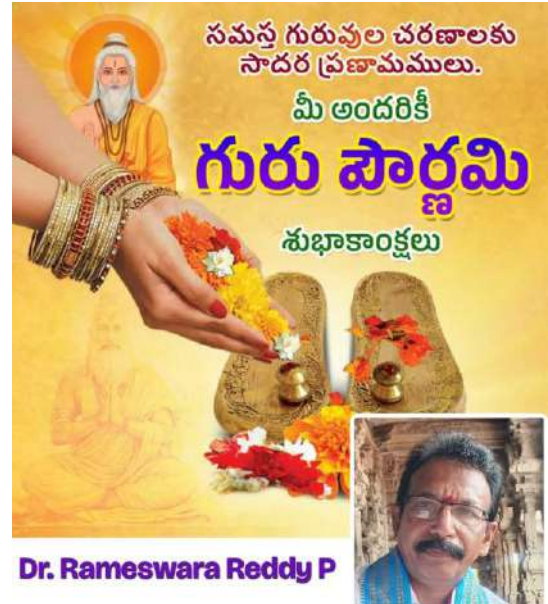

"Ending Plastic Pollution" 19th July, 2025

The *Swachha Andhra - Swarna Andhra* programme was successfully organized at Government Degree College, Mydukur, on 19th July, 2025, as part of the institution's monthly initiative to promote cleanliness and environmental awareness. This programme, held on every third Saturday, aimed to foster a sense of responsibility among students and faculty towards creating a cleaner and greener environment.

The event commenced with **Principal Dr. P. Narayana Reddy** delivering the inaugural address. He emphasized the significance of *Swachha Andhra* and *Swarna Andhra*, particularly highlighting the need to maintain cleanliness across **classrooms, laboratories, the botanical garden, toilets, the surroundings, and the entire campus**. He stated that cleanliness is vital for the health, discipline, and overall development of the academic community.

Following this, **Dr. P. V. Krishna Reddy, NSS Programme Officer**, administered a **pledge to all students and faculty** to uphold cleanliness and contribute actively to environmental protection. He elaborated on the **June 2025 theme - "Ending Plastic Pollution"**, encouraging youth and NSS volunteers to lead by example in promoting sustainable practices, greenery, and the reduction of single-use plastics.

WORLD MANGROVE DAY

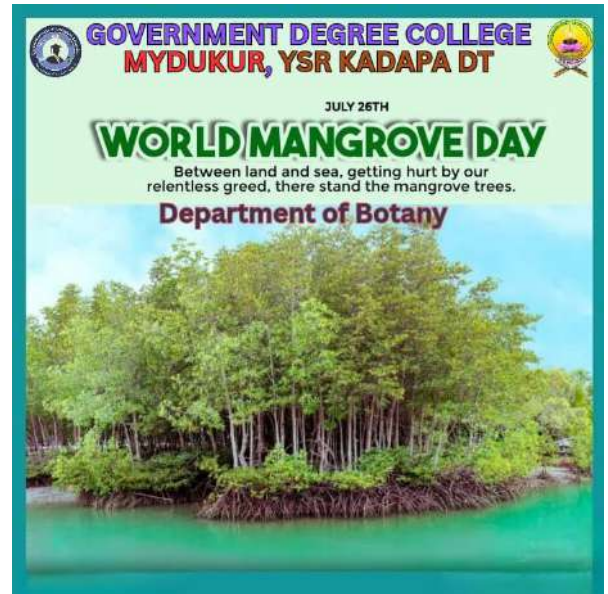
World Mangrove Day Awareness Programme

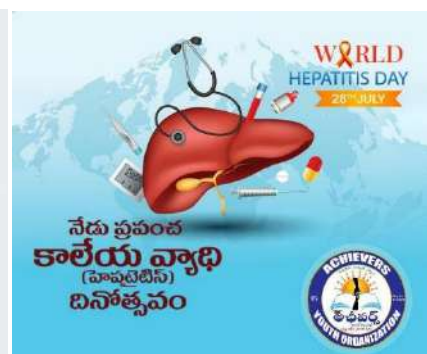
